FUNCTIONS/RESPONSIBILITIES</p> <p>Section 1. <u>Legislative</u></p> <p>SC 301, 407, 510, 511 The Board shall exercise its rule-making power by adopting procedures and policies for the organization and operation of the school district.</p> <p>SC 422, 508 Standing Rules of Procedure of the Board shall be adopted, amended or repealed by a two-thirds vote of the full Board. Policies shall be adopted, amended or repealed by a majority vote of the full Board, provided that each Board member shall have been furnished a copy of the proposed amendment at least one (1) week in advance.</p> <p> The adoption, modification, repeal or suspension of a Board procedure or policy shall be recorded in the minutes of the Board. All current procedures and policies shall be printed in the Board policy manual.</p> <p>Section 2. <u>Executive</u></p> <p>SC 1001 The Board shall exercise its executive power by the appointment of a district Superintendent who shall enforce the school laws of the Commonwealth and the policies of the Board.</p> <p>Section 3. <u>Responsibilities</u></p> <p> The responsibilities of the Board shall be:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. To review and employ all new personnel. The personnel committee and the Superintendent shall make recommendations regarding employment to the Board. b. To approve salaries and wages for school employees. c. To consider and act on policies for the school program. d. To evaluate district programs and the financial status of the schools.
